There is a possibility that the district would not see the \$500,000 short fall at all. He presented three options to move forward. He recommended delaying hiring the deputy chief position and purchasing the deputy chief's vehicle. Commissioner Brink is in favor of the option presented by the chief. Commissioner Van Beek agreed because we want to keep the promises we made to the citizens.

Commissioner Van Beek made a motion to elect option two presented by Chief Carlyle which is to continue the hiring process of the three line personnel, delay the hiring of the deputy chief and purchasing the deputy chief's vehicle, seconded by Commissioner Brink and the motion carried.

1. Purpose

1.1. The purpose of this guide is to establish the general model for scheduling, controlling, and conducting ride-alongs.

2. Scope

2.1. This guide applies to all District members and to participants of the Ride-Along Program.

3. Responsibilities

3.1. Shift officers ensure paperwork is completed prior to starting the ride-along.

4. Revision Summary

Revision Date	Description
7/3/19	Replaces Rule #06-31 (Riders and Observers), adds the required forms as an attachment, adds an additional form describing what a participant may be exposed to, adds a required criminal background report for participants once per year, adds a tracking system for participants, allows Conditional Volunteers same exceptions as EMS students, specifically addresses rules for minors.
3/3/2023	Changes minimum age for ride-alongs to 18, unless participant is part of an approved program.

5. Definitions

5.1. Ride-along – An opportunity given to citizens (including volunteer or career applicants), high school students in the Tri-Tech Skills program, firefighters from other agencies, and paramedic/EMT students to ride-along with Benton County Fire District #4 (BCFD4) personnel when responding to real emergencies and interacting with the community.

6. Guidelines

- 6.1. Ride-alongs should NOT be scheduled with less than 24-hour notice to allow for paperwork completion and scheduling approvals and notifications.
 - 6.1.1. Shift officers can make exceptions on a case-by-case basis for walk-ins.
- 6.2. Personnel scheduling a ride-along should:
 - 6.2.1. Provide notification to the officers of the affected shift, via email, as soon as reasonably possible.
 - 6.2.2. Submit any completed paperwork to the affected shift officer.

- 6.2.3. Add ride-along participant's name and contact information to event calendars (i.e., Public Calendar, CrewSense, or other District calendar software).
- 6.3. Participants are responsible for bringing meals or can arrange to buy-in for meals with the shift officer.
- 6.4. Ride-alongs may be cancelled with little or no notice based on operational needs.
- 6.5. Shift officers submit completed paperwork to the ride-along program manager.
- 6.6. Participants failing to follow Dress and Appearance (Section 7) or Rules of Conduct (Section 8) may be asked to leave and to reschedule the ride-along.

7. Dress and Appearance

- 7.1. Participant shall be neat and clean in appearance. Personal hygiene and grooming must be acceptable to the shift officer.
- 7.2. The following clothing items are prohibited:
 - Open toe shoes
 - Sandals
 - High heels
 - Shorts
 - Tank tops
 - Garments with pictures, writing, or messages except as allowed in 7.5 below.
 - Garments that are excessively loose
- 7.3. Loose jewelry (normal fitting rings and watches are acceptable).
- 7.4. Long hair shall be pulled back and tied so as not to interfere with activities.
- 7.5. Conditional Volunteers and EMS student ride-alongs may wear agency uniforms with prior approval.

8. Rules of Conduct

- 8.1. Participants must conduct themselves in a manner that will not interfere with District operations.
- 8.2. Participants must act in a manner which reflects a positive image of the District.
- 8.3. Ride-along time should be scheduled between 0800 and 1800 and may be extended by the shift officer on a case-by-case basis.
 - 8.3.1. Conditional Volunteers and EMS students may schedule time, as necessary, to meet individual program needs.
- 8.4. The number of ride-alongs should be limited to one per month unless prior arrangements have been made with the Fire Chief or designee.
- 8.5. Participants are encouraged to ask questions, but at appropriate times.
- 8.6. No firearms or other weapons may be brought onto District property or carried during the ride-along.

- 8.7. No alcoholic beverages or drugs are allowed on the premises. The smell of alcoholic beverages, marijuana, etc., on the breath will prohibit participation in the program.
- 8.8. Use of tobacco products is not permitted in any station or vehicle.
- 8.9. Participants are prohibited from taking pictures or using a video or audio recording device while on the scene of an incident.
 - 8.9.1. Photos and recordings of non-incident activities require approval of the shift officer.
 - 8.9.2. Media ride-alongs are handled separately by the Fire Chief or designee.
- 8.10. Participants must be at least 18 years old, unless the participant is part of the Conditional Volunteer Program or a volunteer applicant.
- 8.11. Ride-along length should be limited to no more than eight hours per day.

9. Ride-Along Participant Tracking and Criminal Background Report

- 9.1. Complete the Criminal Background Report as follows:
 - 9.1.1. Have the participant sign the "Acknowledgement and Authorization for Background Check" AND the "Disclosure Regarding Background Investigation" found in Attachment 1.
 - 9.1.2. If the participant is a minor, have a parent/guardian also sign an "Acknowledgement and Authorization for Background Check" form found in Attachment 1.
 - 9.1.3. Have signed forms submitted to the District background investigation company.
 - 9.1.4. Attach returned Criminal Background Report to the Ride-Along packet.
- 9.2. Update the Ride-Along Participant Tracking Spreadsheet.
 - 9.2.1. Ensure the Ride-Along Participant Tracking spreadsheet contains the most recent information regarding the participant. The spreadsheet contains the following information, at a minimum, and is located on the Public Server in the Forms\Ride Along folder:
 - 9.2.1.1. Participants name.
 - 9.2.1.2. Date of last Criminal Background Report.
 - 9.2.1.2.1. If the Criminal Background Report is greater than one year old, then ensure an updated report is completed according to Section 9.1.
 - 9.2.1.3. Location or link to criminal background report.
 - 9.2.1.4. Date of ride-along.

10. Documentation

- 10.1. The following items are required prior to starting a ride-along for EACH participant (all forms or reports can be found on the District server or printed from the attachment of this guide):
 - 10.1.1. Signed Ride-Along Checklist.
 - 10.1.2. Signed Confidentiality Agreement.
 - 10.1.3. Signed Hold Harmless Agreement.
 - 10.1.4. If participant is a minor, signed Minor Release form.
 - 10.1.5. Signed Activities Description.

Activities Description

The BCFD4 Ride-Along Program is designed to provide an opportunity for citizens, students, and potential volunteer or career responders to work alongside the crews during a normal day of work. The program provides the public and students the opportunity to observe activities of fire and EMS services to gain a better understanding of the duties and responsibilities for fire and EMS personnel. Because we cannot determine the types or numbers of incidents that may occur, we cannot provide any guarantees in that area. The crews for the day will do their best to include participants in the day's activities and provide many opportunities to allow for questions and provide detailed explanations.

Because we may respond to any number of incidents, it is possible that participants may witness things that may be disturbing or upsetting to some. While we will do what can to shield participants from harm, our focus must be first on the safety of our staff and the participants, and then on the care and service we provide to those who call for help. I am writing in response to your request for a brief summary of what has occurred. A levy error was discovered for Benton County Fire District #4 ("Fire 4") EMS for the 2023 tax year. As a result of a clerical error, the Fire 4 EMS levy lid lift that was passed in 2022 was not included on the taxes assessed for 2023. This resulted in an under-levy of \$470,490.63.

We have been in communication with the Washington State Department of Revenue to determine how to proceed. When an under-levy occurs, Washington law provides at RCW 84.52.085(1) that the remedy is an adjustment in the following year(s) taxes to recover the money omitted as a result of the under-levy. Fire 4 may wish to spread the levy error correction over three years, and we will work with you to consider the options provided by statute.
