  - Attended the Tri-Cities Ironman Planning meeting.
    - i. First meeting was a meet and greet. Standing monthly meeting as they work through the year to develop the plans for the September 2024 event.
    - ii. The area has made a three year commitment to host the event.
  - o Attended the SEWA IMT AAR for 2023
    - i. Recruiting and succession planning was the major topic.
    - ii. Switching next year to the CIMT which collapses type 1 and 2 teams under one umbrella and expands the scope of the type 3 teams.
  - Attended the Liz Loomis Communications meeting and discussed work plan for December.
    - Topic of if we need to be on the ballot in 2024 was discussed due to dropping fire levy rates. Needs to be a discussion point if we want to attempt to be on the ballot in 2024.
